THE MANIFESTATION OF THE FUNCTIONAL APPROACH IN LANGUAGE TEACHING METHODS: THE ROLE OF DTS, PROGRAMS, TEACHING AIDS, AND TEXTBOOKS IN TEACHING ENGLISH

2. Programs:

Programs designed with a functional focus emphasize interactive activities such as role-playing, group discussions, and problem-solving. Such programs were observed to enhance students' ability to use English in authentic contexts.

3. Teaching Aids:

Visual aids, digital tools, and realia (authentic materials) were found to significantly improve learner engagement and retention. Teachers highlighted the effectiveness of multimedia resources like videos, language apps, and interactive whiteboards in promoting active participation.

4. Textbooks:

Textbooks aligned with the functional approach prioritize situational dialogues, task-based learning activities, and cultural content. However, disparities were observed in the extent to which textbooks incorporated functional language practices, with some favoring traditional grammar drills over communicative tasks.

5. Challenges:

While the functional approach is widely endorsed, teachers reported challenges such as inadequate training, limited access to advanced teaching aids, and a lack of consistency in textbooks' functional orientation.

Discussion

The research underscores the necessity of a holistic approach to language teaching that seamlessly integrates DTS, programs, teaching aids, and textbooks.

The functional approach represents a paradigm shift in English language teaching, moving away from rote learning towards dynamic and interactive methods. DTS, programs, teaching aids, and textbooks collectively play a pivotal role in actualizing this approach, fostering communicative competence in learners.
